PRIVATE SECTOR ENGAGEMENT

 <u>DFI Working Group on Blended Concessional Finance for Private Sector Projects,</u> <u>Joint report, 2019</u>. This report provides an update on the core outcomes of work by the Development Finance Institutions working group in 2019.

WOMEN'S ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

• <u>Women's Economic Empowerment: Transforming Systems through Development</u> <u>Practice, Bramm and Jones, 2019</u>. This book presents market systems approaches for women's economic empowerment, describes the circumstances under which each approach could be applied, and illustrates with examples and case studies from across the world.

GREEN GROWTH

 Greening Development Co-operation: Lessons from the OECD Development Assistance Committee, OECD, 2019. This book examines critical areas for mainstreaming environment across development co-operation activities and suggests priority actions for the OECD-DAC and the wider development community. <u>Green and Inclusive Business Toolbox, GIZ, updated 2019</u>. This toolbox contains examples of approaches and practices from GIZ projects that work in the field of promoting green and inclusive businesses. Four new tools have recently been added under finance, capacity development, and policy.

ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT

- <u>Small Matters: Global evidence on the contribution to employment by the self-employed, micro-enterprises and SMEs, ILO, 2019</u>. Drawing on a database of 99 countries, the report finds that 70% of global employment is in small economic units; in some low-income countries, this share can rise to 90%. Overall, 62% are in the informal sector.
- <u>SME Performance Measurement Toolkit, ILO, 2019</u>. This toolkit is a practical resource for organisations providing support to SMEs to help them decide what aspects of SME performance to measure, as well as how to measure them.
- Management Practices in the Private Sector: A Summary of IGC Research, IGC, 2019. This report summarises the last ten years of IGC research on the links between improving management practices and productivity in developing countries.
- Learning to SCALE effective enterprise development, Argidius Foundation, 2019. This animated mini-series summarises what Argidius has learned from its monitoring and evaluation on how enterprises grow to increase revenue and employment.

EMPLOYMENT CREATION

- How job creation fits into the broader development challenge, Carter and Sedlacek, CDC 2019. Aimed at impact investors and DFIs, this paper argues that the goal in developing countries should be to replace informal, unstable jobs that pay poorly with formal, stable jobs that pay well. Gross job creation, rather than net job creation, should be the preferred indicator.
- <u>What Works: Promoting Pathways to Decent Work, ILO, 2019</u>. This report presents the main findings from a multi-year research project assessing how income support and active labour market policies can come together to improve workers' outcomes.

YOUTH EMPLOYMENT

 Youth associations and cooperatives: getting young people into work, ODI, 2019. This report aims to understand how youth associations can address the challenges typically faced by under- or unemployed youth and to capture the lessons learned by the Youth Empowerment Through Agriculture programme.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TRENDS

 Horizon East Africa: Exploring trends set to shape the future in East Africa, Msingi, Kenya Markets Trust, and Gatsby Africa, 2019. This report presents a snapshot of what institutions and experts are saying about the prospects for economic development in East Africa.
