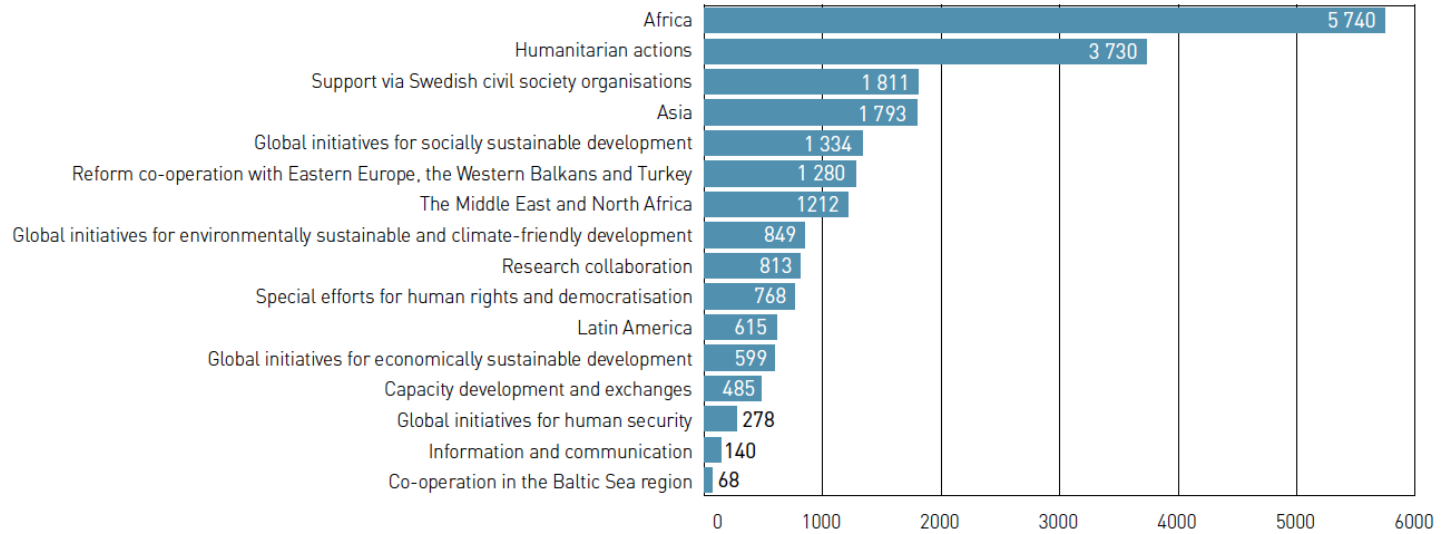

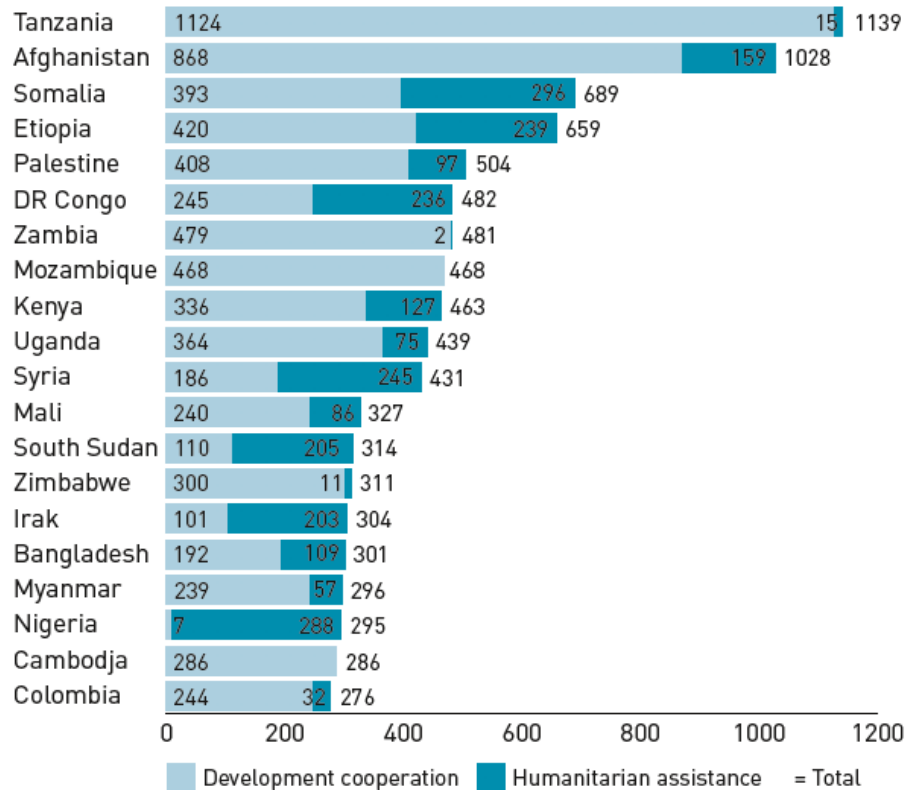

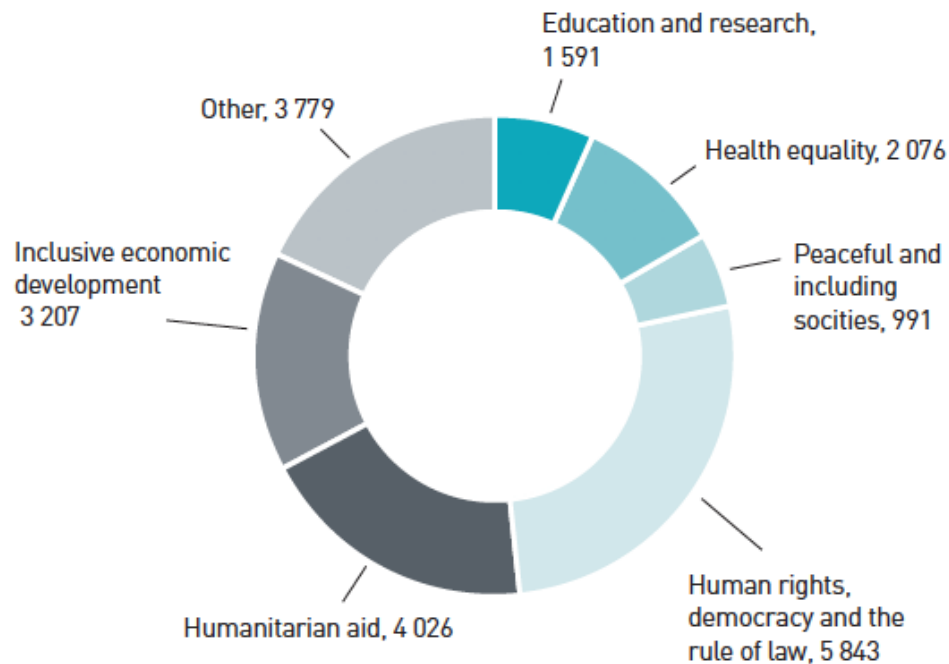
SIDA'S OPERATIONS, PAYMENTS PER APPROPRIATION 2017 (MSEK)

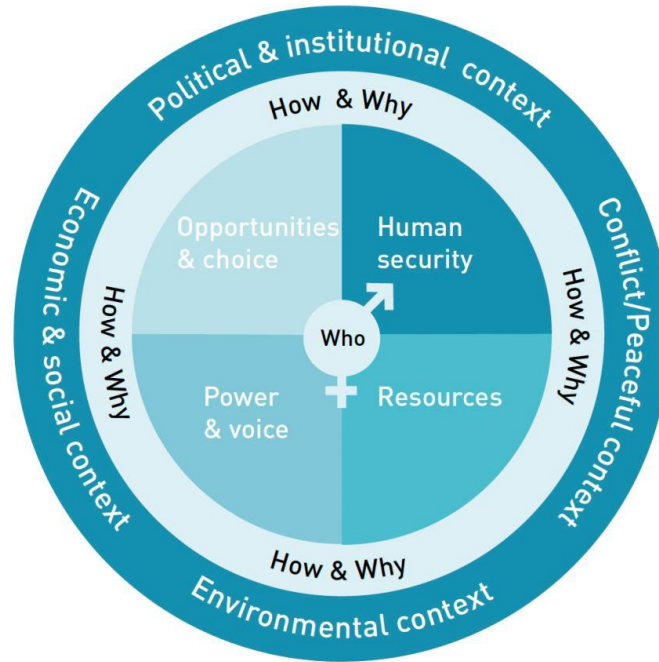
